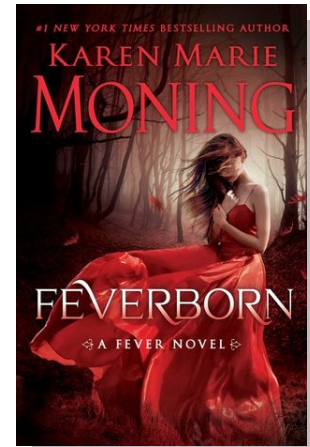
The Bands of Mourning by Brandon Sanderson (FIC SANDERSON, B.)

Mercenary Kate Daniels knows all too well that magic in post-Shift Atlanta is a dangerous business. But nothing she's faced could have prepared her for this.



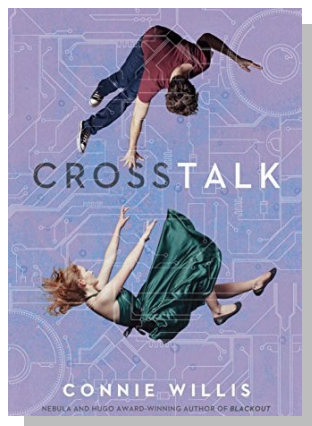
Marked in Flesh by Anne Bishop (FIC BISHOP, A.)

Meanwhile, Humans First and Last organization has been making themselves known, after the attacks in the previous book that killed numerous Others along with their "Wolf Lover" friends, they are not backing down. Little do they know it's not the Others humans need to be wary of but the Elders for which the Others act as a buffer. This is an excellent installment in the novels of the Others, exciting, heart-wrenching and suspenseful.
