



# ATLAS Multi-Library Geocaching Competition

Acorn Public Library District will again be participating in the annual library geocaching competition! So whether you are an avid geocacher or are just starting out, here's what you need to know:

## What is geocaching?

Geocaching is a real-world treasure hunt using GPS coordinates to locate hidden objects.

## That sounds like fun! How do I participate?

Visit your home library to receive your clue card. Each of the 29 participating libraries has provided GPS coordinates to the location of their cache. For additional help, they have also provided a clue, which can be unscrambled using the decoder at the bottom of the page. These two pieces of information will lead you to the exact location of the library's hidden object!

## How old do I have to be to join the competition?

Geocaching is a family event, so individuals of all ages can participate!

## Awesome! I've found the cache! Now what do I do?

Every cache you find earns you a chance to win a **\$25 Amazon gift card!** Head to the service desk listed on or near the geocache to fill out a raffle ticket. Once you've found the caches at all 29 libraries, return your clue card to your home library.
