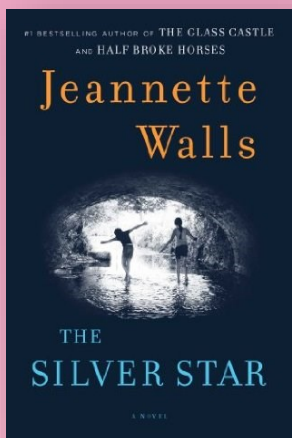
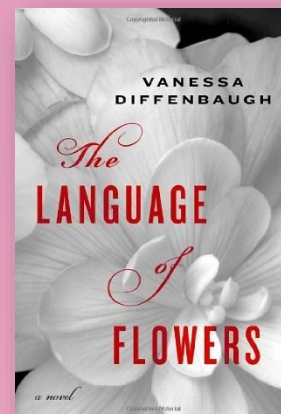
Boy, Snow, Bird by Helen Oyeyemi (Fic Oyeyemi, H.)
