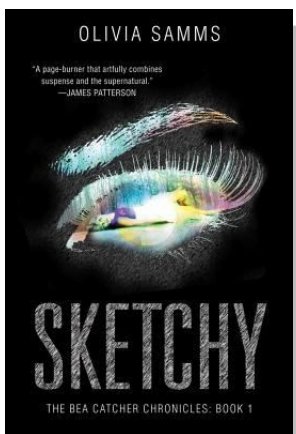
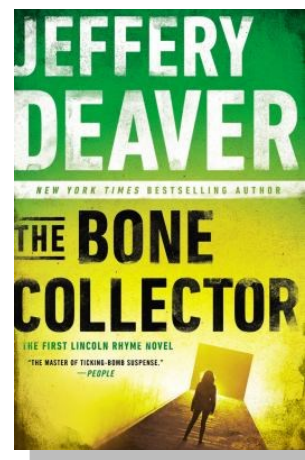
L.A. Mental by Neil McMahon (FIC MCMAHON, N.)
