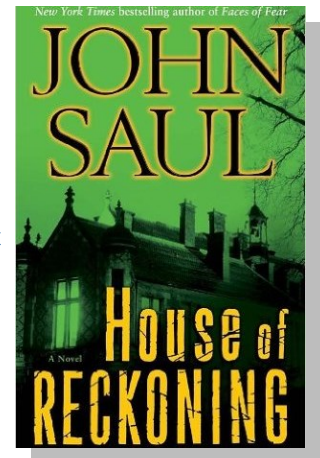
**The Supernatural Enhancements** by Edgar Cantero (FIC CANTERO, E.)

**The Last Day of Magic** by Mark Tompkins (FIC TOMPKINS, M.)

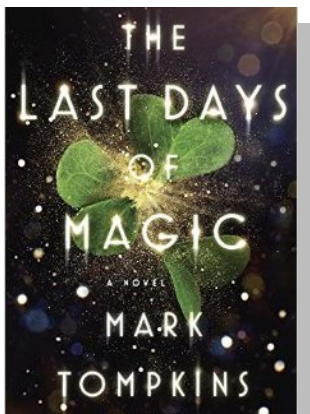
