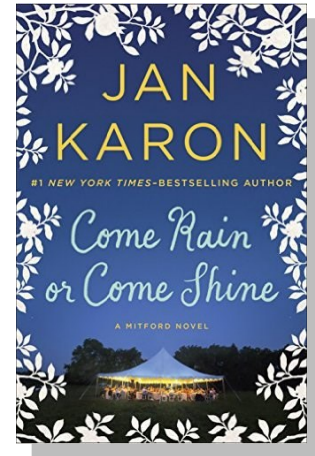
Come Rain or Shine by Jan Karon (FIC KARON, J.)

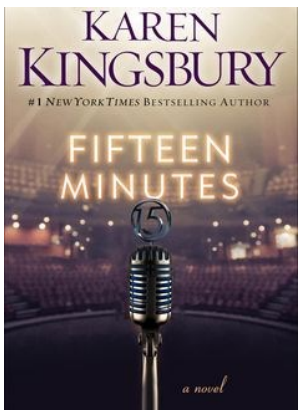
Fifteen Minutes by Karen Kingsbury (FIC KINGSBURY, K.)
