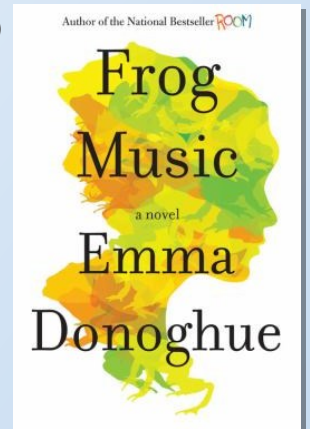
**Dog years** by Mark Doty (BIOG DOTY, M.)

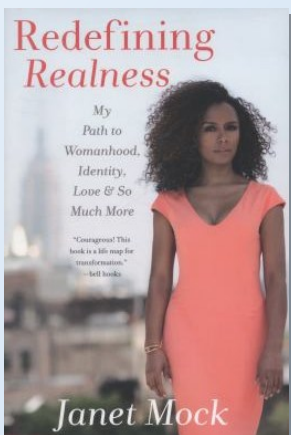
**Eminent outlaws : the gay writers who changed America** by Christopher Bram (810.9 BRA)
