**Thanksgiving Prayer** by Debbie Macomber (PB Macomber, D.)

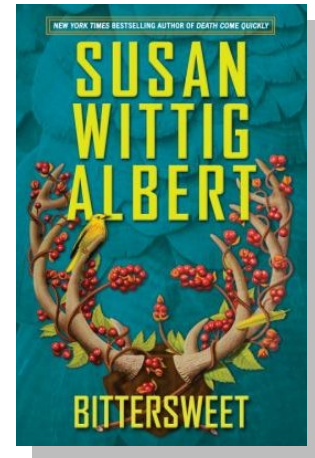
**The Ramblers** by Aiden Donnelley Rowley (FIC ROWLEY, A.)

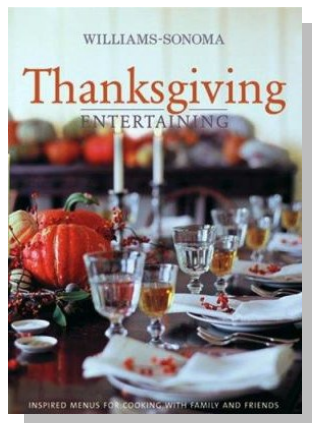


**Thankless in Death** by J.D. Robb (Myst Robb, J.)
