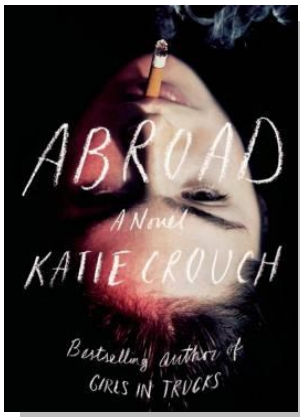
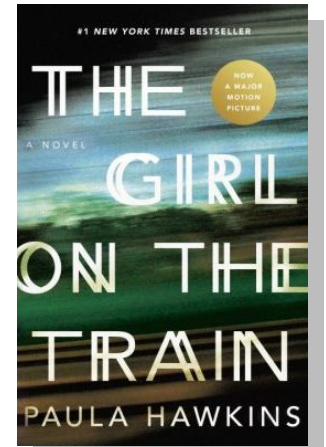
**The Other** by David Guterson (CD FIC GUTERSON, D. UNA)
